

How to Play

1. Each week you MUST select three drivers to race.

a.) Each driver is given a salary

b.) Each week you will select three drivers that total up to \$10 million dollars.

c.) To change a driver, click the "Make Trade" to the right of the drivers and click "drop." You will then be able to select a different driver.

2. You MUST select three drivers NO MORE – NO LESS. If you select less than three drivers you will be awarded zero points for that race. Your three drivers' collective value must equal \$10-Million total—no more—no less.

3. Points are awarded just as they are awarded at the La Crosse Fairgrounds Speedway:

Points will be deducted from drivers penalized by the speedway/NASCAR.

In addition, points will be awarded for the top 10 positions in qualifying. *In the event of a rainout for qualifying, no points will be awarded.*

1st (fast time): 6 points

2nd: 5 points

3rd: 4 points

4th: 3 points

5th: 2 points

6th – 10th: 1 point each

4. The full season at the La Crosse Fairgrounds Speedway begins on Saturday, April 24th, 2010 and concludes on Saturday, September 4th, 2010. For nights with double features, the team you lock in at the start of the night—is the team that will be utilized for scoring both features that evening.
5. Driver selections will be locked in at 7pm every Saturday night, regardless if there is a delay at the track. *There is no penalty for garnering “inside information” as to who’s running that night by tuning into “Clason GMC’s Trackside” each Saturday night, broadcasting live from the racetrack on CC106.3. As a matter of fact, it is encouraged that you DO tune in to know who is in attendance on any given night and who is having problems and may end up pulling out of the competition for the evening, prior to setting your team.*
6. You can join the league at any time during the season.
7. All ties after each race will be broken by random drawing.

Contest Rules

1. In order to win prizes all registration must be completely filled out. If at any time the registration information submitted is determined to be invalid you will be immediately dropped from the league.
2. Awarded points stay with the driver, even if he ends up running a different car.
3. The league competes in NASCAR Whelen All-American Series sanctioned points races at the La Crosse Fairgrounds Speedway.
4. Prizes must be picked up at the La Crosse Radio Group offices by the person registered as the team owner no later than 30 days after the game ends or prize will be forfeited. No prizes will be mailed.
5. One team per person.
6. CC106.3 has the right to make changes as necessary in regards to rules and discrepancies regarding points awarded at anytime throughout the 2010 NASCAR Late Model season
7. Contest is only open to residents within a 50-mile radius of La Crosse, WI.
